## Expressing our Faith...

### **Daily Prayer:**

- † Each new day begins with a small prayer service during morning announcements. Students lead our student body through scripture readings and prayer.

### **Weekly Liturgy:**

- † We practice our Catholic faith weekly by attending Mass every Thursday morning (Grades K-8).

### **The Sacraments:**

- † We prepare our students for their First Reconciliation and First Eucharist.
- † We participate in weekly Eucharist during school mass.
- † Students in grades 2-8 participate in regular Reconciliation Services.

### **Eucharistic Adoration:**

- † All students participate in Eucharistic Adoration at least once per month, although more frequent attendance is encouraged. Adoration takes place on Wednesday's at St. Agnes Parish.

### **Holy Rosary:**

- † Our students are taught how to pray the Rosary and we incorporate praying the Rosary throughout the school year.

### **Retreats:**

- † Students in grades 5-8 participate in annual retreats either on site, at the Norbertine Center or Camp Tekawitha.
